YourChoiceRxSM Prescription Drug Plan

YourChoiceRx is an innovative prescription drug benefit introduced by UniCare Life & Health Insurance Company (UniCare) that is based on the concept of reference pricing. Like many traditional prescription drug plans, YourChoiceRx is a tiered prescription drug plan. The major difference from traditional formulary-based plans is how YourChoiceRx classifies drugs and determines copayments.

YourChoiceRx places drugs into common therapeutic drug categories such as diabetes and antihistamines. Each category has a "reference price." The "reference price" is what UniCare determines to be the average cost of a drug within a category of medications. It is dependent on a number of variables including, but not limited to, the actual cost of the drug, utilization patterns and other clinical considerations. The reference price is used to help determine member copayment levels. UniCare uses the reference price as a reference point and structures member copayment levels both above and below the reference point. Each copayment level corresponds to a specific copayment amount as illustrated below. Please see your certificate of coverage for the specific copayment amount assigned to each copayment level for your plan.

Copayment	Prescription
Level 1	All generics and all diabetic supplies
Level 2	Brand drugs that cost less than the reference price
Level 3	Brand drugs that cost more than the reference price
Level 4	Self injectables

YourChoiceRx In Action

The table below illustrates the different copayment levels provided under YourChoiceRx. Because YourChoiceRx gives you a broad choice of pharmacy benefits, it is in your best interest to take a more active role in the decisions about your prescription medication. For example, if you are diagnosed with high cholesterol your doctor may discuss the prescription choices of Lovastatin, Lescol, Crestor, Zocor, Lipitor, Pravachol and Mevacor. The table below shows where these drugs fall in relation to the reference price in the Heart/Cardiovascular therapeutic drug category and an illustrative copayment amount of each copayment level.*

Level	Drug	Copayment Amount*
Level 1	Lovastatin	\$ 10-15
Level 2	Lescol, Crestor	\$ 20-35
Level 3	Zocor, Lipitor, Pravachol, Mevacor	\$ 40-70

Using this information, you can talk with your doctor and participate in the decision of which medication is best-suited for your condition and financial situation. Unlike most prescription drug plans based on a traditional drug formulary, YourChoiceRx gives you the freedom of greater choice and more control over out-of-pocket expenses.

YourChoiceRx benefits are applicable only to those members who are enrolled in the YourChoiceRx Prescription Drug Plan. Members should refer to their certificate of coverage for complete details including applicable benefits, limitations and exclusions.
